

## AMSAF “20 Under 20” CONTEST RULES

The subject/idea/theme of all submitted entries should explain why you or someone you nominate should be chosen to be granted a free rider course or discounted rider course through Team Arizona or any other training facility chosen at the sole discretion of Arizona Motorcycle Safety and Awareness Foundation (AMSAF) in a contest promoted by AMSAF (Sponsor).

The winner of this contest is required to follow all rules and meet all requirements, without exception, of TEAM Arizona (or any other rider training facility) and AMSAF, and the AMSAF sponsored “20 under 20” contest. The failure to follow any rule will result in the forfeiture of the right to further participate in the prize. Any failure to follow rules of Team Arizona will result in forfeiture of gift certificate or any other prize or gift with no liability of any kind to Team Arizona or AMSAF.

This is voluntary activity. It has physical components and may not be suitable for all people. Ride and participate at your own risk. Riding a motorcycle is an activity that can be inherently dangerous and involves risks that may cause serious injury or in some cases death.

By accepting the opportunity to train with TEAM Arizona or any other training facility, you voluntarily assume the risk and danger of injury or death inherent in this activity.

**30 day deadline:** You have one week (7 days) from the date you are notified of winning the contest to arrange a date for your training. Your training ride must be completed within 30 days of the date you win the contest.

### **Deadlines:**

There is no current deadline but AMSAF and Team Arizona reserve the right to end the contest at any time.

### **Submission Guidelines:**

1. The contestant and anyone else submitting the entry is 100% responsible for all content of their submission.
2. All submissions will become the property of Sponsor.
3. Any submission deemed inappropriate or unsuitable, in Sponsor's sole discretion, will be disqualified.
4. The submission must be the original work of the contestant.
5. If, in Sponsor's sole discretion, the entry (or any portion thereof) appears to have resulted in any injury or bodily harm, it will be disqualified. Entries must be in keeping with Sponsor's image and may not be offensive, as determined by Sponsor in its sole discretion, or Entry will be disqualified from the Contest.
6. Only those old enough to earn a motorcycle endorsement, under the age of 20 years old, and already carrying a valid Arizona driver's license and eligible to earn a valid Arizona motorcycle endorsement are eligible to win.

### **Prizes:**

1. Grand Prize: ONE rider training course at TEAM Arizona (Either Basic Rider Course or Confident Rider Course) or other training facility as chosen by AMSAF. Runner-up Prize: \$100 discount from TEAM Arizona (Either Basic Rider Course or Confident Rider Course) or other training facility as chosen by AMSAF.
2. That any personal or other information you provide may be provided to third parties and by participating in this contest you give the contest sponsors permission to use that information in the promotion of this contest and in any way that advances the purposes of this contest.

### **Release:**

1. By submitting an Entry, you hereby grant the Sponsor, its affiliates, subsidiaries, assigns, licensees, and legal representatives the irrevocable, perpetual, royalty-free, worldwide right to use, reproduce, edit, market, store, distribute, have distributed, publicly and privately display, communicate, publicly and privately perform, transmit, have transmitted, create derivative works based upon, and promote the Entry (as such may be edited and modified by the Sponsor in its discretion) for editorial, commercial, promotional and all other purposes (including posting on any websites). In addition, you hereby assign to the Sponsor all rights, titles, and interests that you may be deemed to have in any reproduction, product, or derivative work using or incorporating the Entry.
2. You represent and warrant that: (i) the Entry does not and shall not infringe on any copyright or trademark or any other third-party right other than Sponsor nor violate any applicable law or regulation, (ii) you have the right to grant any and all necessary rights and licenses provided herein, including without limitation, all necessary copyright, trademark and other related rights to the Entry, free and clear of all claims and encumbrances without violating the rights of any person or entity, including any right to privacy or publicity. You waive any right to inspect or approve uses of the Entry or to be compensated for any such uses. You hereby release Sponsor, its affiliates, officers, directors, agents, co-branders or other partners, and any of its employees (collectively, the "Contest Indemnities"), harmless from any and all claims, damages, expenses, costs (including reasonable attorneys' fees) and liabilities (including settlements), brought or asserted by any third party against any of the Contest, Indemnities due to or arising out of your participation in the Contest, or use of your name, likeness, Entry and/or voice, or any other rights granted to Sponsor, including any claims for including but not limited to trademark, copyright, or other intellectual property rights, right of publicity, right of privacy or defamation. You further agree to release and indemnify and hold harmless Contest Indemnities from any and all claims that any commercial, advertising, presentation, web content or any other material subsequently produced, presented, and/or prepared by or on behalf of Contest Indemnities infringes on

your rights as contained in the Entry submission.

3. You hereby represent and warrant that you have read these Official Rules, are fully familiar with its contents and agree to be bound by them. The Contest and the Official Rules shall be exclusively governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the state of Arizona, without regard to conflicts of law provisions. Entrants submit to exclusive personal jurisdiction in Arizona state and agree that any dispute shall be brought in the state and federal courts in Arizona state.

1. Sponsor shall determine the winner in any way it wishes, whether by personal choice, private vote, public vote, or any other means of any kind, subjective or objective, in its sole discretion
